



Nut Allergy/Anaphylaxis Awareness

With regards to individuals who have been diagnosed with anaphylaxis to nuts or any other product, Oasis Christian Camp:

- Has removed all nut products and chocolate off the shelves.
- Breakfast cereals which are guaranteed nut free are clearly marked and served separately from other cereals which “may contain traces of nuts”
- Campers with allergies or other specific dietary requirements are called up first at meal times by a leader from their group to receive their meal which has been cooked separately from the rest of the meal.
- Head Chef and Camp Management have obtained Level 1 & 2 Food Handling Certificate.
- All Oasis staff have recently updated their First Aid qualifications; obtaining Level 2 First Aid Certificate.
- As a back-up for emergency situations, the camp’s First Aid kit contains an Epi-pen. This information is passed onto the leaders of the group.
- Where appropriate Oasis Camp requires a photo of camper/s who suffer from severe anaphylaxis, which is then displayed in the kitchen.
- All groups are required to pass onto Oasis all information relating to special dietary needs and allergies before their group arrives.
